

## Progress Report DEAF SCHOOL SKARDU February 2015

We are pleased to see that the investment of the aid program DEAF SCHOOL SKARDU pays off.

During our visit to PAKISTAN in May 2014 we could hand over an audiometer, donated by LANDESFÖRDERZENTRUM HÖREN SCHLESWIG (an academy for hearing impaired young people in SCHLESWIG/ NORTHERN GERMANY), a mortising machine, 100 hearing aids, cleaning products and batteries to the young couple Afzal Rasool and Aniqā Bano, who are running DEAF SCHOOL SKARDU.

Michael Eggers, the hearing acoustics specialist and member of our organization, had trained Afzal Rasool and Aniqā Bano within two days, to use the audiometer, to produce ear molds and to adapt hearing aids. The photos show that our motto 'help to self-help' is functioning.

Afzal and Aniqā with gratitude told us which great help the donations from GERMANY are for their work.
