

## Visits to Partners August 2022



### 1. HASHIM WELFARE HOSPITAL (HWH), 1 – 4 August 2022

During the days in PINDI HASHIM together with Dr. Idrees Awan, (Chairman HASHIM WELFARE ASSOCIATION), HJGerber commissioned a carpenter in GUJRAT to construct the furniture he had designed for the newly set up dentistry treatment room and he developed the plans for a HASHIM WELFARE HOSPITAL Guest House and an Office.

### 2. NARJIS KHATOON SCHOOL FOR DEAF SKARDU (NKSD) , 6 August 2022

On the first day of a NORTHERN AREA TOUR, a visit to the NKSD to SKARDU was on the agenda. The purpose of the visit was to hand over certificates and 6,000 PakRps each for the 14 'young artists' whose paintings were exhibited in GERMANY and who had found lovers for a donation of €50.

The school administration, students and parents gathered at the school and greeted HJGerber warmly with colorful bouquets of flowers, clapping and using sign language as a means of expression. It was with great joy and

gratitude that they heard from HJGerber about the interest and recognition of the pictures shown in Germany.

- 3. SAYA SCHOOL MAIRA AKKU, 13 August 2022** During a visit to the SAYA SCHOOL MAIRA AKKU together with PHzSHeV member Arsalan Minhas, his wife Dr. Humera Minhas, José and Sonia, two friends from Spain, could see what has been achieved with funding from PHzSHeV in the last three years. The paved school yard and the sports field have improved school life considerably and provided opportunities for school sports that were previously unavailable.

The on-site assessment of the situation in connection with the construction and furnishing of a physics and chemistry classroom has resulted in new possible solutions for implementation, which will be the basis for further planning.

- 4. German Embassy ISLAMABAD, 16 August 2022**

During the visit to the German Embassy ISLAMABAD, HJGerber had the opportunity to meet the new Ambassador, Mr. Alfred Grannas, and the Second Secretary for Political, Economic, Development, Klaus Peter Stross, to present the goals and programs of PHzSHeV and to discuss funding opportunities from the Embassy.

During the next visit to PAKISTAN in October, HJGerber will submit applications for financial support of two projects in 2023 to the embassy.

The recent dramatic events in PAKISTAN, which caused millions of people in existential misery with the truly apocalyptic flash floods of this year's monsoon, may put a question mark on plans for 2022.

In the next few weeks, decisions will have to be made on further planning for 2022 in accordance with the current situation.
