

HAQ MODEL SCHOOL PROJECT



For some time now, we and our charity member Jameela Abdul Haq, a young dentist from BERLIN, have been thinking about building a school in AWAN SHARIF, GUJRAT DISTRICT, PUNJAB PROVINCE, PAKISTAN, the village of her ancestors. Jameela has long had the idea of providing primary school education from grades 1-5 to underprivileged children in the village and the surrounding area.



We developed the project idea (needs analysis, construction plan, personnel requirements, equipment, financing plan, etc.) with Jameela and some experts who are friends with her and carried out fact finding on site.



PHASE 1 COSTS: 22.000,- € Call for donations 'BRICKS FOR KIDS'

PHzSHeV will implement PHASE 1 of the project in terms of planning and with charity member Jameela Abdul Haq as project manager on site. A decision on the implementation of PHASE 2 (grades 3–5) will be made in 2026.

Timeline for implementation PHASE 1: Raising donations by October 2024, completion of construction and furnishings in March 2025, first school year to start April 2025.
